The exhibition **Répare Reprise** gives voice to artists from the Middle East and Africa who have experienced exile.

They come from Syria, Lebanon, Palestine, Iraq, Iran, the Golan, Congo DRC, Ethiopia, Algeria, Tunisia and France.

The artists attempt to recompose political imaginaries and repair intimate spaces.

These spaces range from the home as a refuge, by diverting objects and practices associated with the domestic (sewing, weaving, embroidery), to larger commons, such as public archives patiently stripped and decolonized, and new cartographies for territories bruised by war.

The visit of the exhibition is orchestrated by Pauline de Laboulaye.
